CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2014

The Appellation: Colchagua Valley

Set between the coastal mountain range and the Pacific Ocean, our Marchigue vineyard is located just 45 kilometers from the coast in one of the coolest sections of the Colchagua Valley. Given its maritime influence, temperatures are moderate in summer with cool nights. Characterized by its rolling hills, the unique soils in our vineyard are mainly decomposed granite and red clay.

The Vintage: 2014

The 2014 season was characterized by a dry spring and summer months, with moderate temperatures that allow slow ripening curves. As a result, we obtained grapes with strong fresh character, balance and great tannin structure. Overall we are looking at high concentrated and full flavored wines.

The Wine:

Aromas of ripe black fruit and black pepper are complemented with cassis flavors and hints of spice with a long velvety finish.

Winemaker's Notes:

After destemming, the grapes are cold macerated for five days in open top stainless steel tanks and fermented with native yeasts. After primary fermentation, the wine is macerated with its skin for another ten days to achieve greater smoothness and intensity of flavors. Finally, the wine is racked to neutral oak barrels and aged for 12 months.

Varietal Composition: 100% Cabernet Sauvignon

Alcohol: 14%

Oak: 12 months in neutral wood
