FRESH. BRIGHT. CRISP.

The Appellation: Casablanca Valley

The Casablanca Valley is a cool climate area on the north western side of Chile's coastal range less than 30 kilometers from the Pacific Ocean. Our estate occupies the extreme eastern end of the valley and is noted for its gentle Pacific breezes and early morning fog, making it the ideal climate for producing cool climate varietals.

The Vintage: 2013

Growing conditions for this vintage were optimum given its moderate temperatures that translated into slow ripening of the grapes allowing them to maintain its freshness and protect the integrity of the aromas.

The Wine:

Appealing intense strawberry and cherry aromas are mingled with savory spice. The wine displays enticing flavors of cherry and bright citrus on the mid- palate, carrying lush texture and fresh acidity that leads to a long crisp finish.

Winemaker's Notes:

We hand harvested the Syrah in the early morning to keep it bright and fresh. The fruit went whole cluster into the press where it spent a few hours on its skins to gain more color, structure and body. The wine was then gently pressed, pumped into a stainless steel tank and then racked off into another stainless steel tank for cold fermentation, before it was bottled.

Varietal Composition: 100% Syrah

Alcohol: 14%
